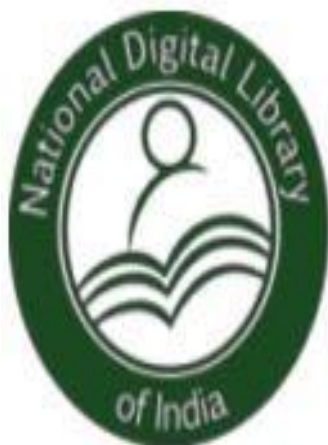

### ABOUT NATIONAL DIGITAL LIBRARY OF INDIA

The **National Digital library of India** is a virtual repository of learning resources which is not only just a repository with a search/browse facilities but also provides a host of services containing textbooks, articles, videos, audio books, lectures, simulations, fiction and all other kinds of learning media for the learners/users community. It is a project under Ministry of Education, Government of India, through its National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT). The objective is to collect and collate metadata and provide full text index from several national and international digital libraries, as well as other relevant sources. The NDLI provides free of cost access to many books and is designed to hold content of any languages and provides interface support for 10 most widely used Indian languages. It is developed, operated and maintained from Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur.

A user awareness programme on "National Digital Library of India" was organized by Grizzly College of Education in collaboration with Ministry of Education entrusted IIT,

Khargpur to develop National Digital library of India (NDLI) on 3<sup>rd</sup> February,2023 at 12 noon. The programme presented by Mr. Suman Panja, Outreach manager, NDLI Club, IIT, Khragpur All pupil-teacher and faculties have joined for the webinar. The Resource Person of the webinar focused on variety of resources available on National Digital Library of India and create awareness among users about NDLI.

NDLI is project of Ministry of HRD under the aegis of National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT) to develop a framework of virtual repository of learning resources with a single-window search facility. NDLI has been developed by Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Kharagpur. It is single window platform that collects and collates metadata from premier learning institutions in India and abroad, as well as other relevant sources. It is open to all at free of cost. It is digital repository 17 million-plus items containing textbooks, articles, videos, audio books, lectures, simulations, fiction and all other kinds of learning media) in 200-plus languages from more than 170 institutions. It has been designed to hold content of any language and provides learning and research interface support for leading Indian languages. It is arranged to provide support for all academic levels including researchers and life-long learners from all disciplines and in all popular form of access devices and also to differently-abled learners.

### **Salient Feature**

- Educational materials are available for users ranging from primary to post-graduate levels.
- NDLI has been designed to benefit all kinds of users like students (of all levels), teachers, researchers, librarians, library users, professionals, differently abled users and all other lifelong learners.
- Information can be personalized based on the education level, choice of language, difficulty level, media of content and such other factors. This is thus like a ‘customised service’ provided in a 24x7 integrated environment where learners can find out the right resource with least effort and in minimum time.
- Repository hosts contents from multiple subject domains like Technology, Science, Humanities, Agriculture and others.
- More than 60 types of learning resources are available - books, articles, manuscripts, video lectures, thesis, etc.

- Items are available in more than 400 languages.
- Repository integrates contents from different Indian Institutional Repositories.

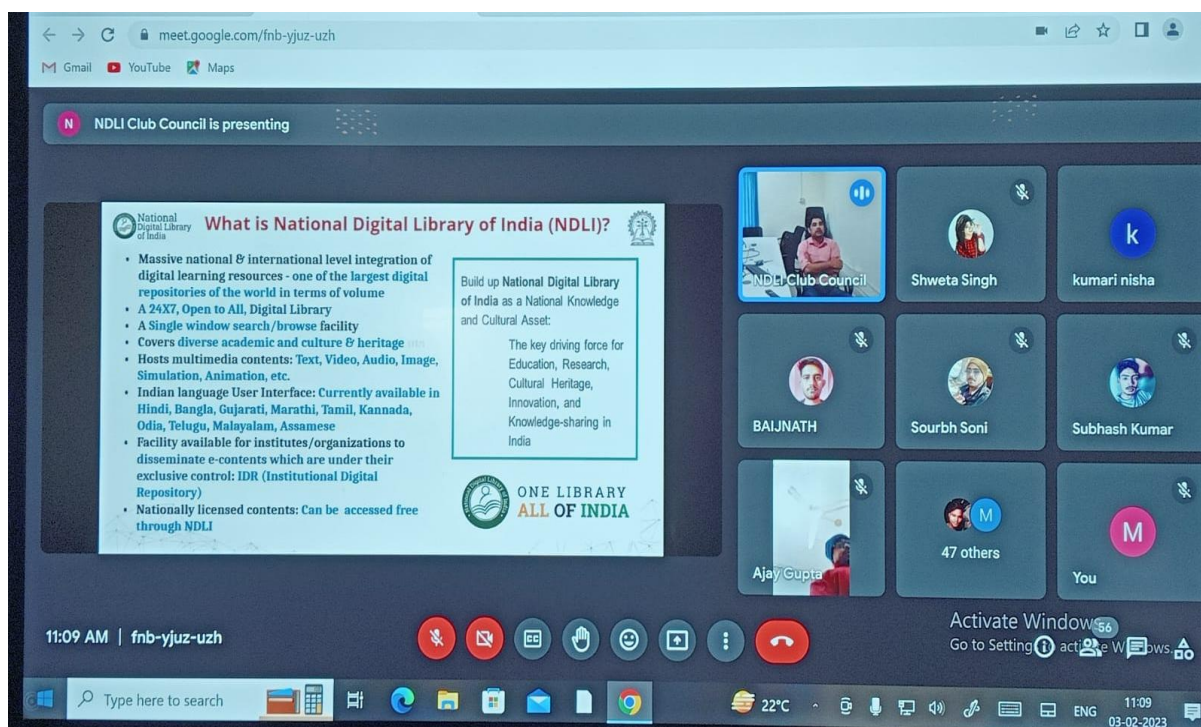

Hon'ble Resource Person Mr. Suman Panja, Outreach Manager, NDLI Club, IIT, Kharagpur

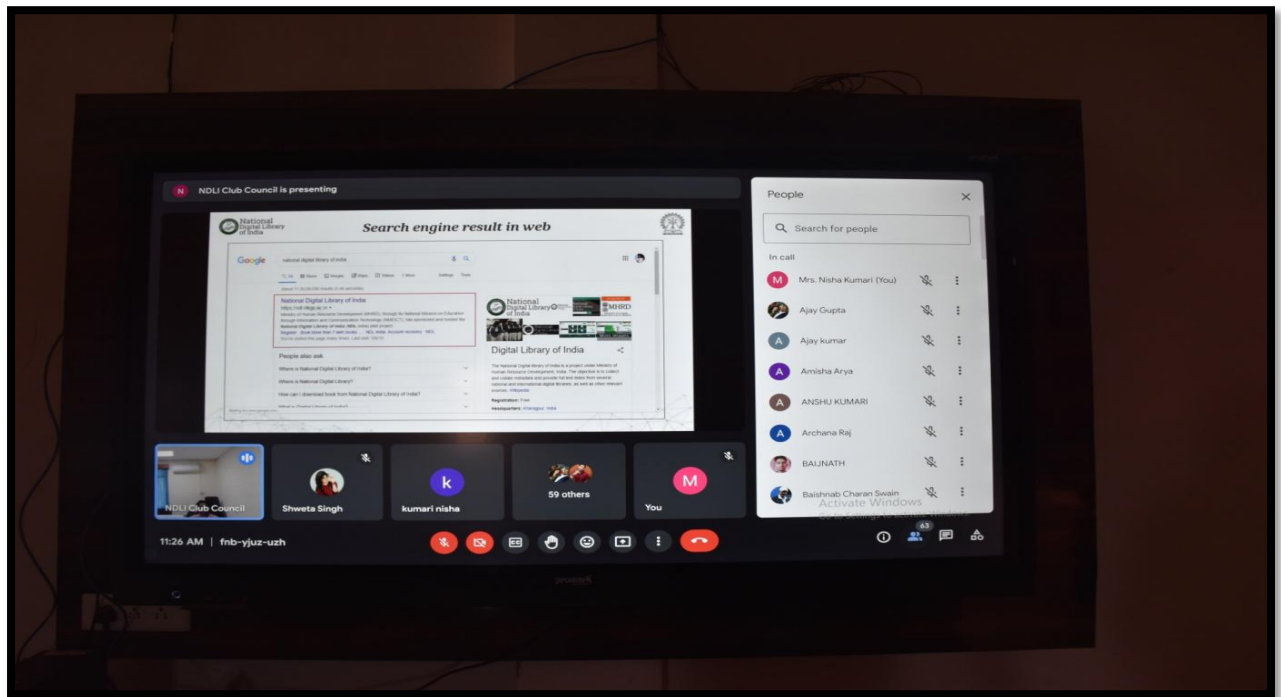

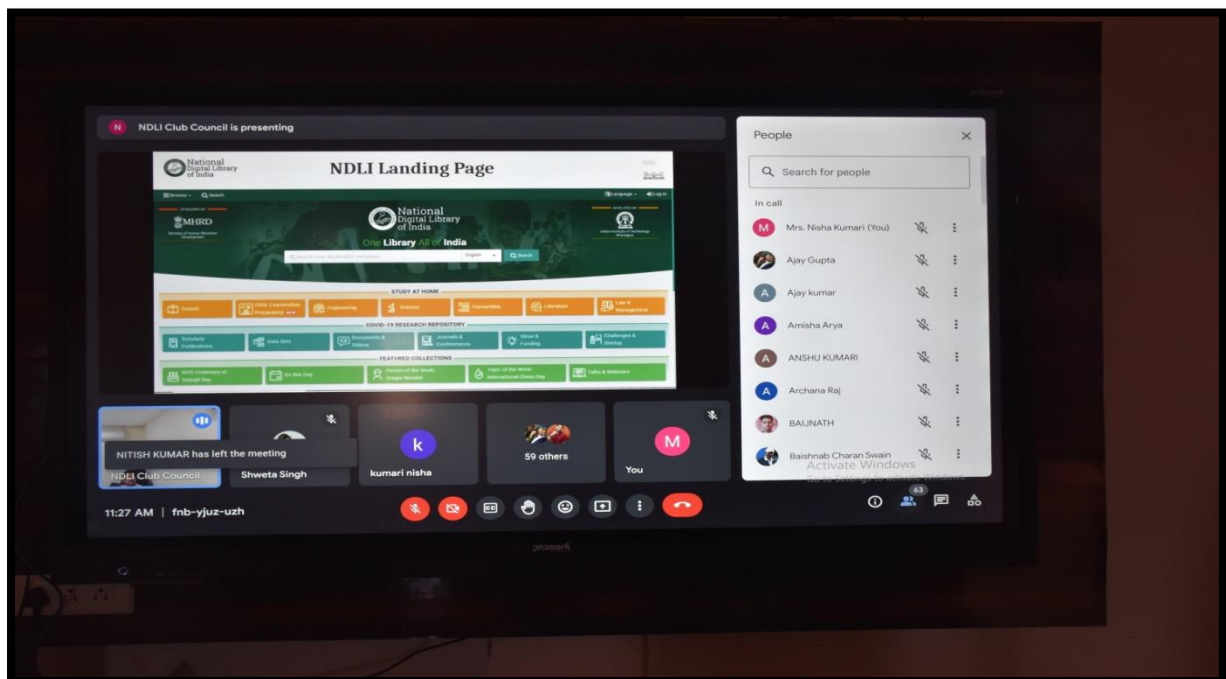
