International Yoga Day 2024



International Day of Yoga 2024: International Yoga Day is celebrated annually on June 21. History and Significance :

He emphasized the importance of yoga as a holistic approach to health and well-being and suggested that June 21 should be declared as International Yoga Day. His proposal received overwhelming support from the UN member states, leading to the adoption of June 21 as International Yoga Day by the United Nations General Assembly on December 2014.

The significance of International Yoga Day lies in its ability to bring people from various backgrounds, cultures, and nations together to celebrate and practice yoga. It serves as a platform for individuals and communities to experience the physical and **mental benefits of yoga** and understand its profound impact on personal and societal well-being. Yoga encourages mindfulness, promotes physical fitness, reduces stress, and cultivates a sense of inner peace and harmony.

Plantation Drive

A plantation drive was successfully conducted on 23rd July,2024 at Jinvani Management College, Ara with the aim of promoting environmental sustainability and enhancing the green cover of the area. The goal of the event was to plant 500 saplings, contributing towards a healthier environment and raising awareness about the importance of trees in combating climate change.

Objectives

The key objectives of this plantation drive were:

- 1. To plant 500 trees in the community, contributing to the local green cover.
- 2. To involve the local community and volunteers in the initiative to create a sense of environmental responsibility.

To spread awareness about the benefits of trees, including reducing carbon dioxide levels, providing oxygen, and improving biodiversity.

1 Preparation and Planning
